

DEFINITIONS

“MCOM” means Murchison Camp Oven Muster

“Tickets” means any form of official admission pass issued by MCOM including official receipt or wristband

“Event” means Murchison Camp Oven Muster

ENTRY

Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any person who:

- Cannot produce a valid ticket.
- Produces a ticket that has been purchased or obtained through an unauthorised source or through illegal means or has been duplicated.
- Is in possession of and refuses to surrender any prohibited or illegal object.
- The Shire of Murchison record the event with photographs, audio and video. By attending the MCOM you agree that you may be included in these. We retain the right to use this material for future promotional purposes.

CONDITIONS OF SALE – GENERAL

Event Organisers will not refund*, provide an exchange or replace any tickets where:

- The ticket holder chooses not to attend the event.
- The ticket is stolen or lost.
- The ticket has been duplicated.
- The ticket holder has been refused entry or evicted from the grounds in any of the circumstances outlined in these Terms and Conditions.
- The event does not meet his or her expectations.
- The incorrect ticket type has been purchased.
- Should unforeseen circumstances or factors beyond MCOM’s control cause disruption or abandonment of the remainder of the Event.
- Should you choose not to attend on the occasion of inclement weather – this is an all-weather event

On the occasion of unforeseen and safety-threatening circumstances, prior to the start of the Event, event organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the Event, with a refund of the amount of the ticket less administration costs.

REFUNDS – GENERAL

Refunds are not available if you change your mind, or if you are unable to attend the event. You may give your tickets to someone else and change the name on the ticket or you may be able to resell your tickets.

GENERAL

Whilst attending the event patrons must not:

- Behave in a threatening or inappropriate manner (aggressive, riotous, abusive or insulting actions) towards other patrons or event staff.
- Light or cause to be lit any unauthorised fires outside of the assigned areas.
- Cause damage to, improperly use, or tamper with any public facility or event infrastructure.
- Litter in the venue or surrounding area. All rubbish is to be disposed of correctly in facilities provided.
- Shire of Murchison and/or security have the right to remove any person, vehicle or camp site which in its opinion contravenes any rights, laws or directions given to visitors.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times for the duration of the festival. Faulty, or damaged wristbands may be replaced by Event Organisers at their discretion. No old armband = no new armband.
- No Smoking is permitted inside buildings, around the food stalls or tent structures.

CAMPING – *Camping is provided by the Shire of Murchison*

Camping is sold per site. Weekend event tickets must be purchased at the time of booking a camping site. Campsites are the same price whether you stay 1 night or up to a maximum of 3 nights *during the available period only*.

Patrons who arrive prior to Thursday 30th July or intend to stay after 2nd August must pay nightly fees as per listed in the Shire of Murchison Fees and Charges. Bookings are to be made via the Murchison Oasis Roadhouse.

Campfires are permitted in the camping areas. However steel drums to contain them must be used and are available from the stables. Firewood is provided. Fires are not to be left unattended.

Generators are allowed – generators hours are between 8 am to 9 pm only.

All water taps on site are non-potable water. We recommend that you arrive to our event with your water tanks full. Drinking water will be made available from the Murchison Community Centre at all times.

Porta potties are to be emptied at the dump point on the grounds near Oasis Roadhouse. Do not empty into toilets on the grounds.

Shire of Murchison cannot guarantee a consistent uninterrupted supply of electricity to your site: therefore, we do not recommend that participants rely on the Shire of Murchison power supply for the running of any medical related equipment.

PETS

Well behaved pets are welcome at the Australian Camp Oven Event.

Owners are responsible for cleaning up any “mess” deposited by their pet. This means YOU need to clean up after your pooch!

Pets are prohibited from food areas – this includes while lining up for food or where food is consumed.

All pets must be on a lead when in public places. Please remember that not everyone loves your pet as much as you, so keep yours under control at all times.

Never leave pets at camp alone if they are going to annoy your neighbours.

ALCOHOL

A bar will open for periods of time over the weekend, designated drinking area will be available, no alcohol is to be taken out of that area.

FIRE PREVENTION & SAFETY

Fires are only allowed in designated areas, in camping areas a steel drum must be used.

Enclosed shoes must be worn on event grounds at all times and special attention paid in areas where there are active fires/coals.

As a fire safety measure could you please leave a full bucket of water near the front passenger side wheel of your vehicle for the duration of your stay.

First aid will be onsite over the event weekend, but they may not be onsite for the entire duration of your stay.

Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times. This supervision is the responsibility of the adult who purchased the ticket for the child.

PROGRAM CHANGES

While every attempt is made to present the program as advertised, the program may be subject to change without notice. No refunds will be given due to a change in programming.

LIABILITY

The Shire of Murchison takes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property. The patron enters the venue at their own risk and to the maximum extent permitted by the law, The Shire of Murchison its employees/volunteers and all other persons involved in the organisation, sponsorship and promotion of the event accept no liability for any injury, loss, claims, costs, expenses or damage which may be suffered or incurred or which may arise directly or indirectly in respect to the supply of goods or services (including liability for negligence) and to the extent permitted by the law in the supply of a recreational service.
