10.2 Discussion on the Road inspection

Cr Foulkes-Taylor wanted to thank the CEO for participating in the inspection. He also wanted to thank Brian, the Works Supervisor, who had given up two days of his annual leave to join Council on the inspection and for the care and knowledge of the shires road network which he displayed throughout the whole trip.

Points noted for action:-

- Shire of Northampton to be contacted about the sign at the boundary on the New Forrest-Yallalong Road which has been erected by the 4WD club. It is misleading and needs to be removed/corrected.
- Need new Coolcalalaya sign at Yallalong Homestead Murchison crossing.
- CEO & Works Supervisor to produce full report on the inspection for presentation to council.

Cr Halleen noted that the roads were basically good and standing up well. This is a credit to the Shire.

Worst road inspected was the New Forrest-Yallalong Road and repairs are needed. Bog holes and crossings need to be addressed this year and can be funded from the heavy maintenance budget. Signs also need replacing as necessary.

Cr Squires also noted that Brian shows passion for his job and his responsibility for the roads. Full compliments to him and his staff.

Cr Halleen suggested that we need to look not only at the roads themselves but also off road with Bunding and drainage to improve the situation and prevent damage to the roads.

Cr McTaggart agreed that the New Forrest-Yallalong Road needs a hard hit with some heavy maintenance work.
