# OFFICERS RECOMMENDATION / COUNCIL DECISION Moved Cr. Halleen seconded Cr. Foulkes-Taylor

#### 6. Announcements by the President

The President advised that Crosslands Resources Ltd ad launched a community support programme entitled Crosslands "@ Heart". Under the programme, funding of up to \$2,000 is available to not-for-profit community groups and organisations that are working towards bringing sustainable benefits to the minwest.

A letter of appreciation had been addressed to Cr. Broad by Ms Karen Morrissey OAM, in which she expressed had gratitude to Council for supporting her attendance at the Australian 2020 Summit.

President's report on the local Government Conference covered content and

format, venue and banners in the terrace. He commended WALGA for its organisation and handling of the conference and made allowance for some minor teething problems. Guest speakers were of the highest standard. The Murchison banner was excellent but regrettably did not win.

Life Membership of the Association was awarded to Cr. Halley Cowan and the President asked that a letter of congratulation be sent to Cr. Cowan.

Council's policy regarding the manner in which the maintenance grading is carried out does not appear to be being fully carried out, the President observed.

Cr Broad concluded by thanking Council for affording him the opportunity to attend the conference and to be accompanied by his wife.

# 7. Items for Discussion without Notice

#### Cr. Mitchell (by telephone hookup)

Told the meeting of current Square Kilometre Array developments, including a request that he investigate the practicality of a road to link the Settlement with the Top Shed. He also fore-shadowed an application by CSIRO for permission to install a temporary building on the site.

#### Cr. Pollock

Gave his impressions of the Local Government Conference and endorsed the President's comments. He thanked Council for the chance to attend.

He regretted that it had not been possible for him to attend the inspection of the CEO's House.

#### Cr. Walsh

Spoke of condition of the Beringarra-Cue Road and drew attention to a dangerous situation at Poonthan Pool. When the maintenance graders were in the vicinity of Mileura they stopped at the woolshed and did not grade to the homestead, nor was the airstrip graded Cr. Walsh said.

Spoil from earthworks carried out on the Mileura airstrip had been dumped on the Mileura-Mt.Hale Road, Cr. Walsh advised.

In his capacity as a member of the Housing Committee Cr. Walsh said that, accompanied by the Acting CEO, he had inspected the vacant CEO's house to confirm that it was ready for occupation. It was found that apart from minor items of wear and tear the house is in good order.

#### Cr. Foulkes-Taylor

Extended a welcome back to the Acting CEO and advised the meeting of his recent visit to Tasmania, he said that it was most concerning to see at first hand the condition of the country, which apart from the north west and some of the north was deplorable.

#### Cr. Halleen

Reported on his involvement with proceedings of the Local Government Conference; he too endorsed the President's remarks. He also echoed the President's concern regarding grading.

In the vicinity of the Yuin-Twin Peaks boundary on the Beringarra-Pindar Road water is collecting on the inside of a bend and creating a traffic hazard; also on the same road the pavement is breaking up at the grid approaches and requires compacting. Cr. Halleen also reported on proceedings of a Rangeland Council meeting he had attended in Albany

#### **Report Purpose**

To allow council to consider funding changes made by Roads to Recovery.

#### **Background**

At the time the budget was prepared and the Works Program drawn up it was believed that funding for the Ballinyoo Bridge was on the basis of 2:1; accordingly \$226,667 of the Roads to Recovery (R2R) funding was diverted to the Beringarra-Pindar, Mt.Gould and Erong Roads.

Advice was received from R2R on8<sup>th</sup> August that the Ballinyoo Bridge project is fully funded by R2R and so adjustment was necessary to allocations for the roads and that R2R had taken the following action:

- re-instated the value for the cost to RTR back to \$680,000 for the Ballinyoo Bridge
- withdrawn Beringarra-Pindar Road from the Program
- reduced funding for the Mt.Gould & Erong Roads by \$10,166.
